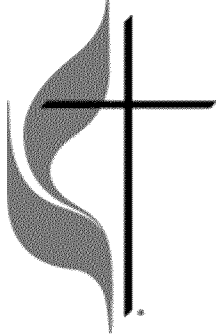

A disturbing phenomenon assaulted me again last Sunday after the 11:03 worship service. For starters, the Bulletin mistakenly listed the sermon title as "Naval Gazing Prohibited" instead of "Navel-Gazing Prohibited", an error that stemmed from a misunderstanding of the term "Navel-Gazing". It never occurred to me that someone might not hold that term in her or his own cultural history. It means wasting time in activity as useless as contemplating your own navel. The term was so common in my past—and I have wasted plenty of time in such activities.

While bantering about navel-gazing with people gathered in the foyer after the service, one, and then another, and then another reported that he or she had never heard that term. Uh oh! I was immediately thrown back to the sermon that I built around the TV series "Gunsmoke". That sermon worked pretty well in the first service, the attendees of which knew "Gunsmoke", but about halfway through the second service it hit me that most of the young listeners had never watched "Gunsmoke", had never fallen in love with Miss Kitty, had never met Sam in the Long Branch, had never floundered through the logic of Festus Hagen, had never limped alongside Chester, had never been treated by Doc, had never crossed the Kansas mountains with Matt (I always thought it hilarious when Matt rode out of Dodge directly into the mountains of board-flat Kansas). That sermon didn't find a home in most of the ears that morning.

Now, on the 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2011, I discover that many have never heard the term "navel-gazing", and I had done it again. My first thought: 'I am getting too old for this.' My second thought: 'Stop making assumptions about what the congregation might find familiar and what it might not.' Communication is usually difficult. Bear with me; I've been at this only 20 years, and I am still very much a beginner.

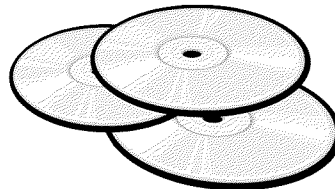
### GENERATION CHANGE

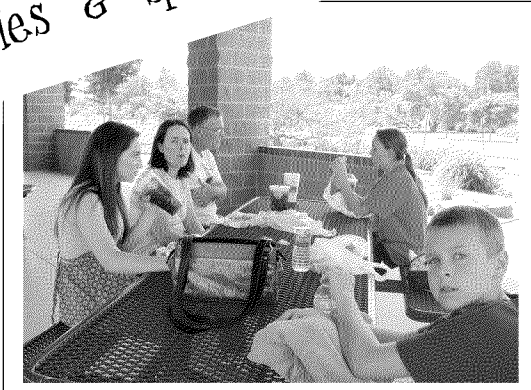

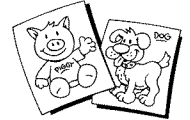

In a world where 250,000 children are forced to be fighters or sex slaves, the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is the largest persistent violator, according to the United Nations Security Council. Because of the war, young boys are forced to enlist in the rebel army. Sexual assault of women and young girls has become the norm.

Compounding the problem is "conflict mineral," the selling of copper, tungsten, tin and other minerals to support war efforts. Unfortunately, minerals sold to global supply chains and corporations may be used as components for electronics that are part of our everyday lives: mobile phones, MP3 players and computers.

United Methodists are trying to do something about it.

Armed with a grant from the **Peace with Justice Sunday offering**, the *Jerusalem Justice and Peace Ministry (JJPM)* is assisting communities in the DRC. While physical and emotional healing is vital, the ministry also challenges unjust systems.

"We cannot keep quiet if there is something wrong," said JJPM executive Dr. Leonard Kabwita. JJPM workshops educate and empower Congolese people about justice issues in their communities and seek local solutions to close the gap between rich and poor.

When you give to **Peace with Justice Sunday**, you support ministries in the DRC, the United States and worldwide to remove unjust systems and equip the victimized to live more fulfilled lives.
