The Primary Task of the Fellowship & Outreach Committee

To address the concerns and conditions of people in the congregation and community so that they may grow in their spiritual life and become better equipped for life as Christian disciples.

Responsibilities of the Fellowship & Outreach Committee

1. To attend meetings and participate in discussion and decision-making.
2. To care for the members of the congregation (including those who are inactive) to help all know and respond to the love of God in Christ.
3. To work with the congregation in developing the gift of hospitality in order to work toward the goal that all people will feel welcome when they enter the church.
4. To learn about the hopes and concerns of people in the congregation and community.
5. To be familiar with the overall goals of the congregation, how these relate to outreach ministries, and how the Fellowship and Outreach Committee might extend the goals of the congregation.
6. To set goals for congregational growth and to plan and execute specific evangelistic events and missions.
7. To develop and carry out programs of membership care, including plans for growth in devotional life.
8. To support the work of the church council.
